Established a Special School for Intellectual Disabled at Saluru, Vizianagaram District which is in the border of Orissa and it is uncovered, and with the support of Sri. S. Ramakrishna (R.K), International Trainer and Consultant on HRD who had provided free accommodation for establishing this centre.


Through National Children's Fund, New Delhi, impletmented the activities/services for the Welfare and Development of Disabled Children by Early Identification, Intervention & Prevention of Childhood Disabilities in Kakinada Rural.

As a part of vocational training, as approved by National Trust, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi, we had developed a Nursery Plantation for improving the quality life of adult persons with disabilities.

Three Continuing Rehabilitation Education programmes were conducted for Rehabilitation Personnel/Professionals on Deafblindness and MDVI (Multiple Disabilities with Visual Impairment) with the approval of Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi at Kakinada, Eluru and Ongole.

To encourage our services, M/s ONGC, Eastern Offshore Asset, Kakinada has provided a School Bus under CSR Initiative on the eve of their diamond jubilee celebration to provide free conveyance to the special need children those who are in remote areas to utilize the services of this centre. This was inaugurated on 14th Aug 2016 by the officials of ONGC, Kakinada.

As there are no sufficient professionals are available in the field of Deafblind, we have developed infrastructure to introduce the D.Ed. SE(DB) Teachers Training Institute with the support of Sense International India.





This organization is conducting Data Entry Computer Training Programme at Special Schools for the Children with Intellectual Disabilities, Kakinada and Ongole with the technical support of AMBA Organization, Bangalore. They have provided 20 Laptops with required software for these two centres.

The Secretary and the Director of Social Services Department, Government of Sri Lanka visited this organization as an exposure visit along with 11 Block Development Officers and Executive Director, CBTD, Sri Lanka to observe the services which this organization is providing to the PWDs for the purpose of implementing the system of working in their Country.

Conducted Community Coaches Training programme on 9th Sep 2016 and District Level Special Olympics sports at 3rd battalion APSP grounds, Kakinada on 30th Sep 2016 with the support of Special Olympics Bharat. Smt. P. Anantha Lakshmi Satyanarayana Murthy, M.L.A., Kakinada Rural constituency has inaugurated and other District officials have participated.



Basic Needs India, Bangalore has organized 7 Days Residential Psychosocial Reintegration Camp for people recovering from mental illness and their families in collaboration with Uma Educational and Technical Society, Kakinada from 4th to 10th Oct 2016.

Conducted State Level Training Programme on Deafblindness to Medical and Paramedical professionals at Eluru, West Godavari District on 26.10.2016 to sensitize on the Prevention, Screening and Assessment, Early Identification and Intervention of Deafblindness.

Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad have visited this organization on 8th Dec 2016, satisfied the performance of this organisation and provided Study Centre for B.Ed, SE (MR) Course through Distance Mode for the academic year 2016-17.

Conducted consultancy workshop with District Authorities and CSR groups on Mental Health status in East Godavari District and Role of Stakeholder at Senate Hall, JNTU, Kakinada on 14th Feb 2017 supported by CBR Forum, Bangalore in coordination with Basic Needs India, Bangalore.

To Create barrier free environment to the newly constructed multi storied building, we have erected an elevator (lift) for this building with the generosity of AFP Operations AS, Norway through their Indian Office, Kakinada and Inaugurated by Lars Oddvar Aulesjord, VP Operation & Production AFP Operations AS, Norway on 22nd Feb 2017.

COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION PROJECT FOR PWDS

We are implementing Community Based Rehabilitation programme at I.Polavaram Mandal, East Godavari District, A.P. and Yanam, Puducherry (UT) with the support of Andheri Hilfe Bonn. Mainly focusing on Health, Education, Livelihood, Social and Empowerment to persons with different abilities and to create awareness on disability, its causes, prevention, schemes, entitlements and advocacy & lobbying. Formation and promotion of disabled people's organizations for strengthening their sustainability and capacity building. Creating suitable vocational and skill training to the deserved youth and providing financial support for self- employments for sustaining economic development through organization and disabled people's organizations.

District Disabled Peoples Organization is formed under the supervision of Uma Educational and Technical Society, Kakinada, on completion of assigned DLI CBR Project with the support of CBR Forum, Bangalore for sustainability of the beneficiaries under this scheme, was handed over to the District Disabled Peoples Organization (Asharaya Zilla Vikalangula Samakya) East Godavari District to maintain its survival and sustainability.

◀ SPECIAL EDUCATION TRAINING INSTITUTES

As a part of developing the human resources, this organization is conducting a 2 year Diploma level Special Education Training courses recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi in association with National Board of Examination in Rehabilitation.

- D.Ed.SE(MR) at Kakinada, East Godavari District Intake Capacity 30 per year
- 2) D.Ed.SE(HI) at Parivarthan Special School for Hearing Impaired, Eluru, West Godavari Intake Capacity 25 per year
- 3) B.Ed.SE(MR) Course (Distance Mode) through Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad.
- Conducting Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) programmes with the approval of Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi.

On completion of these courses the trained educators will get eligibility for employment opportunities in Government / NGO sector and can provide education to special need children.



◀ AN INTEGRATION OF CHILD PROTECTION SCHEME (CHILDLINE 1098) AT YANAM

Childline 1098 is a national 24-hours free phone emergency outreach service for children in need of care and protection up to the age of 18 years. Abandoned, Orphans, Destitute, Missing, Run away, Street Children, Child labours and Children affected by Physical /Sexual/Emotional, Trafficking, Differently Abled, HIV/AIDS Infected, Dropout and Child marriages etc.

Childline India Foundation (CIF) is the nodal agency of the Union Ministry of Women and Child Development acting as the parent organization for setting up, managing and monitoring the Childline 1098 services all over the country. M/s CIF has awarded the same to UETS as Collaborative Organization at Yanam for implementing the Childline 1098 activities.

TARGET INTERVENTION PROJECT FOR MIGRANT COMMUNITY, EAST GODAVARI.

We are implementing Target Intervention Project for Migrant Community project with the support of National AIDS Control Organization, New Delhi through A.P State AIDS Control Society, Amaravathi. The main objective of this project is to reduce and control the prevalence of HIV/AIDS especially bridge population i.e., Destination Migrants. During this year we have covered 9 Revenue Mandals of East Godavari with Migrant population of 14194.


